Overall Self-Response Rates in NC

59.0% of households in NC have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and Aug 2, 2020. The top performing state is Minnesota (72.2%). North Carolina is currently ranked 35 out of 50 states and D.C. for self-response rate. Nationally, 62.8% of households have self-responded to the census.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in North Carolina?

46.1% of NC households responded to the census online versus 50.2% of households nationwide.

12.9% of NC households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.6% of households nationwide.
