How is Beaufort County performing?

48.5% of households in Beaufort County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **51.8**%. Beaufort County is currently ranked 51 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Beaufort County?

28.8% of Beaufort households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

19.7% of Beaufort households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
