# Chatham County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 3

#### **How is Chatham County performing?**

**59.3**% of households in Chatham County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **51.8**%. Chatham County is currently ranked 5 out of 100 counties in NC.

#### How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Chatham County?

50.4% of Chatham households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

**8.9%** of Chatham households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
