How is Davidson County performing?

55.6% of households in Davidson County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Davidson County is currently ranked 15 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Davidson County?

45.5% of Davidson households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

10.1% of Davidson households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
