# **Durham County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 3**

### **How is Durham County performing?**

**51.3**% of households in Durham County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **51.8**%. Durham County is currently ranked 35 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Durham County?

47.0% of Durham households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

**4.3%** of Durham households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
