

# Forsyth County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 3

## How is Forsyth County performing?

**54.6%** of households in Forsyth County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Forsyth County is currently ranked 20 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Forsyth County?

**47.1%** of Forsyth households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

**7.5%** of Forsyth households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
