How is Gaston County performing?

50.9% of households in Gaston County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Gaston County is currently ranked 39 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Gaston County?

40.7% of Gaston households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

10.2% of Gaston households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
