

## Hoke County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 3

### How is Hoke County performing?

**47.2%** of households in Hoke County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Hoke County is currently ranked 53 out of 100 counties in NC.

### How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Hoke County?

**37.3%** of Hoke households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

**9.9%** of Hoke households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
