How is Iredell County performing?

58.2% of households in Iredell County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Iredell County is currently ranked 7 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Iredell County?

50.4% of Iredell households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

7.8% of Iredell households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
