55.6% of households in Mecklenburg County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Mecklenburg County is currently ranked 15 out of 100 counties in NC.

51.0% of Mecklenburg households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

4.6% of Mecklenburg households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
