How is Moore County performing?

49.7% of households in Moore County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Moore County is currently ranked 44 out of 100 counties in NC.

40.5% of Moore households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

9.2% of Moore households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
