

# Robeson County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 3

## How is Robeson County performing?

**38.3%** of households in Robeson County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Robeson County is currently ranked 84 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Robeson County?

**18.5%** of Robeson households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

**19.8%** of Robeson households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
