

Surry County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates – Week Ending May 3

How is Surry County performing?

51.2% of households in Surry County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Surry County is currently ranked 36 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Surry County?

36.6% of Surry households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

14.6% of Surry households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
