How is Union County performing?

50.6% of households in Union County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 5, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **41.7%**. Union County is currently ranked 2 out of 100 counties in NC.

- **47.3%** of Union households responded to the census online versus 35.7% of all NC households.
- **3.3%** of Union households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.0% of all NC households.
