63.7% of households in Catawba County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 5, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **58.1**%. Catawba County is currently ranked 10 out of 100 counties in NC.

49.3% of Catawba households responded to the census online versus 45.4% of all NC households.

14.4% of Catawba households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.7% of all NC households.
