How is Chatham County performing?

66.4% of households in Chatham County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 5, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **58.1%**. Chatham County is currently ranked 5 out of 100 counties in NC.

53.7% of Chatham households responded to the census online versus 45.4% of all NC households.

12.7% of Chatham households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.7% of all NC households.
