How is Forsyth County performing?

60.7% of households in Forsyth County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 5, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **58.1%**. Forsyth County is currently ranked 23 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Forsyth County?

50.2% of Forsyth households responded to the census online versus 45.4% of all NC households.

10.5% of Forsyth households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.7% of all NC households.
