

# Catawba County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending June 7

## How is Catawba County performing?

**62.9%** of households in Catawba County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and June 7, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **57.0%**. Catawba County is currently ranked 9 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Catawba County?

**48.8%** of Catawba households responded to the census online versus 44.8% of all NC households.

**14.1%** of Catawba households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.2% of all NC households.

Historic census self-response rates for Catawba County were 66.0% in 1990, 66.0% in 2000, and 68.3% in 2010.
