How is Craven County performing?

60.3% of households in Craven County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and June 7, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **57.0%**. Craven County is currently ranked 20 out of 100 counties in NC.

48.4% of Craven households responded to the census online versus 44.8% of all NC households.

11.9% of Craven households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.2% of all NC households.
