How is Forsyth County performing?

59.9% of households in Forsyth County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and June 7, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **57.0%**. Forsyth County is currently ranked 23 out of 100 counties in NC.

49.7% of Forsyth households responded to the census online versus 44.8% of all NC households.

10.2% of Forsyth households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.2% of all NC households.
