How is Craven County performing?

58.1% of households in Craven County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 10, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **54.5%**. Craven County is currently ranked 17 out of 100 counties in NC.

47.4% of Craven households responded to the census online versus 43.5% of all NC households.

10.7% of Craven households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.0% of all NC households.
