# Currituck County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 1

## **How is Currituck County performing?**

**42.1%** of households in Currituck County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 10, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **54.5%**. Currituck County is currently ranked 80 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Currituck County?

- 37.7% of Currituck households responded to the census online versus 43.5% of all NC households.
- **4.4%** of Currituck households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.0% of all NC households.
