How is Gaston County performing?

53.7% of households in Gaston County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 10, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **54.5%**. Gaston County is currently ranked 39 out of 100 counties in NC.

41.9% of Gaston households responded to the census online versus 43.5% of all NC households.

11.8% of Gaston households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.0% of all NC households.
