How is Iredell County performing?

60.9% of households in Iredell County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 10, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **54.5%**. Iredell County is currently ranked 8 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Iredell County?

51.5% of Iredell households responded to the census online versus 43.5% of all NC households.

9.4% of Iredell households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.0% of all NC households.
