How is Wake County performing?

63.8% of households in Wake County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 10, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **54.5%**. Wake County is currently ranked 3 out of 100 counties in NC.

59.6% of Wake households responded to the census online versus 43.5% of all NC households.

4.2% of Wake households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.0% of all NC households.
