## **How is Buncombe County performing?**

**55.7%** of households in Buncombe County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 17, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **55.7%**. Buncombe County is currently ranked 36 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Buncombe County?

48.9% of Buncombe households responded to the census online versus 44.1% of all NC households.

**6.8%** of Buncombe households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.6% of all NC households.
