

Catawba County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 17

How is Catawba County performing?

61.5% of households in Catawba County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 17, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **55.7%**. Catawba County is currently ranked 9 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Catawba County?

48.1% of Catawba households responded to the census online versus 44.1% of all NC households.

13.4% of Catawba households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.6% of all NC households.
