

Chatham County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 17

How is Chatham County performing?

63.2% of households in Chatham County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 17, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **55.7%**. Chatham County is currently ranked 5 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Chatham County?

52.1% of Chatham households responded to the census online versus 44.1% of all NC households.

11.1% of Chatham households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.6% of all NC households.
