41.1% of households in Duplin County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 17, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **55.7%**. Duplin County is currently ranked 87 out of 100 counties in NC.

17.2% of Duplin households responded to the census online versus 44.1% of all NC households.

23.9% of Duplin households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.6% of all NC households.
