# Wake County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 17

## How is Wake County performing?

**64.9%** of households in Wake County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 17, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **55.7%**. Wake County is currently ranked 3 out of 100 counties in NC.

#### How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Wake County?

60.3% of Wake households responded to the census online versus 44.1% of all NC households.

**4.6%** of Wake households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.6% of all NC households.
