

Wayne County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 17

How is Wayne County performing?

55.1% of households in Wayne County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 17, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **55.7%**. Wayne County is currently ranked 38 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Wayne County?

38.7% of Wayne households responded to the census online versus 44.1% of all NC households.

16.4% of Wayne households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.6% of all NC households.
