# **How is Buncombe County performing?**

**45.7%** of households in Buncombe County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **46.6%**. Buncombe County is currently ranked 38 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Buncombe County?

- 44.6% of Buncombe households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.
- **1.1%** of Buncombe households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
