# Hoke County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 19

# How is Hoke County performing?

**42.6%** of households in Hoke County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **46.6%**. Hoke County is currently ranked 58 out of 100 counties in NC.

# How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Hoke County?

**34.8%** of Hoke households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.

**7.8%** of Hoke households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
