

Mecklenburg County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 19

How is Mecklenburg County performing?

50.1% of households in Mecklenburg County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **46.6%**. Mecklenburg County is currently ranked 13 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Mecklenburg County?

47.7% of Mecklenburg households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.

2.4% of Mecklenburg households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
