

# Moore County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 19

## How is Moore County performing?

44.1% of households in Moore County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **46.6%**. Moore County is currently ranked 49 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Moore County?

38.2% of Moore households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.

5.9% of Moore households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
