# **How is Robeson County performing?**

**36.3**% of households in Robeson County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **46.6**%. Robeson County is currently ranked 81 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Robeson County?

17.5% of Robeson households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.

**18.8%** of Robeson households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
