How is Rowan County performing?

46.7% of households in Rowan County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **46.6**%. Rowan County is currently ranked 29 out of 100 counties in NC.

- 43.2% of Rowan households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.
- **3.5%** of Rowan households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
