

# Union County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 19

## How is Union County performing?

**56.6%** of households in Union County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **46.6%**. Union County is currently ranked 2 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Union County?

**53.0%** of Union households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.

**3.6%** of Union households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
