How is Beaufort County performing?

In 2020, **18.6%** of households in Beaufort County have filled out the Census questionnaire from March 12, 2020 to March 23, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **16.6%**. Beaufort County is currently ranked 21 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Beaufort County?

9.6% of Beaufort households responded to the census online versus 13.1% of all NC households.

9.0% of Beaufort households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 3.5% of all NC households.
