

Carteret County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates – Week of March 23

How is Carteret County performing?

In 2020, **11.5%** of households in Carteret County have filled out the Census questionnaire from March 12, 2020 to March 23, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **16.6%**. Carteret County is currently ranked 93 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Carteret County?

10.4% of Carteret households responded to the census online versus 13.1% of all NC households.

1.1% of Carteret households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 3.5% of all NC households.
