How is Cumberland County performing?

In 2020, **16.8**% of households in Cumberland County have filled out the Census questionnaire from March 12, 2020 to March 23, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **16.6**%. Cumberland County is currently ranked 49 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Cumberland County?

- 13.7% of Cumberland households responded to the census online versus 13.1% of all NC households.
- **3.1%** of Cumberland households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 3.5% of all NC households.
