How is Duplin County performing?

In 2020, **17.0%** of households in Duplin County have filled out the Census questionnaire from March 12, 2020 to March 23, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **16.6%**. Duplin County is currently ranked 47 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Duplin County?

5.1% of Duplin households responded to the census online versus 13.1% of all NC households.

11.9% of Duplin households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 3.5% of all NC households.
