How is Henderson County performing?

In 2020, **18.6**% of households in Henderson County have filled out the Census questionnaire from March 12, 2020 to March 23, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **16.6**%. Henderson County is currently ranked 21 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Henderson County?

- 13.9% of Henderson households responded to the census online versus 13.1% of all NC households.
- **4.7**% of Henderson households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 3.5% of all NC households.
