In 2020, **17.0**% of households in Wayne County have filled out the Census questionnaire from March 12, 2020 to March 23, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **16.6**%. Wayne County is currently ranked 47 out of 100 counties in NC.

11.0% of Wayne households responded to the census online versus 13.1% of all NC households.
