# **How is Cherokee County performing?**

**43.1%** of households in Cherokee County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 25, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **56.4%**. Cherokee County is currently ranked 83 out of 100 counties in NC.

# How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Cherokee County?

17.0% of Cherokee households responded to the census online versus 44.4% of all NC households.

**26.1%** of Cherokee households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.0% of all NC households.
