How is Franklin County performing?

54.6% of households in Franklin County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 25, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **56.4%**. Franklin County is currently ranked 46 out of 100 counties in NC.

38.8% of Franklin households responded to the census online versus 44.4% of all NC households.

15.8% of Franklin households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.0% of all NC households.
