

Guilford County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 25

How is Guilford County performing?

62.2% of households in Guilford County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 25, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **56.4%**. Guilford County is currently ranked 10 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Guilford County?

51.2% of Guilford households responded to the census online versus 44.4% of all NC households.

11.0% of Guilford households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.0% of all NC households.
