

Pasquotank County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 25

How is Pasquotank County performing?

59.8% of households in Pasquotank County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 25, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **56.4%**. Pasquotank County is currently ranked 18 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Pasquotank County?

43.1% of Pasquotank households responded to the census online versus 44.4% of all NC households.

16.7% of Pasquotank households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.0% of all NC households.
