# **How is Currituck County performing?**

**36.4%** of households in Currituck County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 26, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **48.5%**. Currituck County is currently ranked 84 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Currituck County?

35.6% of Currituck households responded to the census online versus 41.0% of all NC households.

**0.8%** of Currituck households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 7.5% of all NC households.
