How is Forsyth County performing?

50.7% of households in Forsyth County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 26, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **48.5%**. Forsyth County is currently ranked 18 out of 100 counties in NC.

45.5% of Forsyth households responded to the census online versus 41.0% of all NC households.

5.2% of Forsyth households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 7.5% of all NC households.
